Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services, as per the shortlisting criteria below:

	Criterion	Relevant Documentation to be provided in EOI
1.	Delivering at least one training program in E-Game Design and Development for Young Learners.	A detailed brief about at least one training program in E-Game Design and Development delivered for young learners within the past 5 years, including the project's implementation start and end date, project budget, number of training hours, mode of delivery, location, number of beneficiaries, assessed impact, project implementation partners and any other relevant details.
2.	Experience working with incubators, accelerators or gaming companies in Jordan.	A detailed brief outlining the scope of work previously implemented with incubators, accelerators or gaming companies, including the context of the partnership, the objectives and outcomes.
3.	Demonstrated financial stability	Audited financial statements for the last 2 years or other proof of financial stability
4.	A proof of Registration	Registration documentation (e.g., commercial registration, trade licenseetc.)

The EOI package should not exceed **20** pages in total and should consist of documentation that demonstrates the company's qualifications above

Note: Key staff will not be individually evaluated at the shortlisting stage.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Section III, paragraphs, 3.14, 3.16, and 3.17 of the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" September 2023 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest. Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications, but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the **Consultants' qualifications Selection (CQS)** method set out in the Procurement Regulations.
