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1. Introduction:

Ministry of Digital Economy and Entrepreneurship (MODEE) is soliciting proposals from qualified bidders to supply the following:

Responses to this request for proposal (RFP) must conform to the procedures, format and content requirements outlined in this document.

Deviation from procedures, format and content requirements will be considered grounds for disqualification.

2. Scope of work:

2.1: The scope of work of this tender includes delivering, installing, configuring, maintaining, providing support and warranty of RFID readers & RFID tags for Electronic Toll Collection (ETC) System Harana – Omsari Toll Road.

All RFID readers & RFID tags must meet MODEE technical specifications defined in this RFP

2.2: The Winning bidder must deliver the required RFID readers & RFID tags within 3 weeks-calendars day as of the date of signing the purchase order (contract) and the delivery will be at Harana toll Plaza, Azraq and MoPWH HQ, Amman.

3. Technical Specifications and Details:

Bidders must comply with the following minimal technical specifications and requirements for (RFID readers & RFID tags), therefore bidders are required to comply in full with these technical specifications and requirements and any proposal that does not comply with these technical specifications and requirements shall be rejected for being none responsive. Bidders must be specifying the manufacturer and the origin of countries of the submitted [devices]

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4. General Terms and Conditions:

This RFP is subject to the Government Procurement Regulation no. (8) For the year 2022, and the instructions issued pursuant to it and their amendments.

5. Special Terms and Conditions:

- Project duration 1 months for implementation start from the commencement date.
- The Bidder shall supply, install, configure, test and commission the RFID readers, RFID tags, antennas, mounting accessories, cabling and all ancillary equipment required for a complete and operational RFID reading system at Harana Toll Plaza in accordance with the tender's technical specifications.
- The Bidder shall conduct a detailed site survey prior to commencing the Works and shall verify dimensions, clearances, power availability, communication routes, mounting locations, and all other site conditions necessary for successful installation.
- Upon completion of the Works, the Bidder shall provide complete as-built documentation, including equipment layouts, wiring diagrams, cable schedules, configuration records, IP addressing, equipment manuals, and maintenance documentation.
- The existing Toll Management System (TMS), lane control system, toll collection software, back-office system and communication infrastructure shall remain under the Employer's control. No modifications to these systems are included within the scope of this Contract.
- Integration of the supplied RFID equipment with the existing Toll Management System, lane controller, payment system, central database or any third-party software is specifically excluded from the scope of this Contract.
- The supplied RFID readers shall support open industry-standard communication interfaces and protocols, including Ethernet (TCP/IP), RS-232/RS-485, configurable GPIO and documented APIs or SDKs (where applicable), to facilitate the integration by the Employer.
- All RFID readers and RFID tags shall comply with the technical specifications contained in the tender documents and with the applicable international standards,

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including ISO/IEC 18000-63 and EPCglobal Class 1 Generation 2 (Gen2/Gen2v2).

- Installation shall be undertaken in a manner that minimizes disruption to toll plaza operations. Any interruption to lane operations shall be coordinated with and approved by the Employer.
- The Bidder shall provide operational and maintenance training to personnel nominated by the Employer, including equipment configuration, diagnostics, preventive maintenance and firmware update procedures.
- The Bidder shall guarantee the availability of spare parts, firmware updates and technical support for a minimum period of ten (10) years from the date of commissioning.
- The supplied RFID equipment shall be capable of future integration with toll management systems, lane controllers and Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) through the provision of standard communication interfaces and documented protocols, without requiring replacement of the supplied hardware.
- The Bidder shall be responsible for the design (where required), construction, and installation of all civil, structural, electrical, and mechanical infrastructure necessary for the complete installation and commissioning of the RFID readers and associated equipment. This shall include excavation, trenching, ducting, concrete foundations, reinstatement of pavements, mounting structures, equipment supports, cable routing, power and communication cabling, earthing, lightning protection, and any ancillary works required for a fully operational system. The Bidder shall verify all site conditions prior to execution of the Works, and no additional payment shall be made for infrastructure works necessary to achieve complete installation unless expressly provided for in the Contract.
- All electrical installation works shall comply with the applicable national electrical regulations and recognized international standards.
- Firmware updates released during the warranty period shall be supplied at no additional cost.
- The Bidder shall perform Site Acceptance Testing (SAT) demonstrating compliance with the Contract requirements, including tag reading performance, equipment functionality, communication interfaces, diagnostics, and environmental operation.
- The Employer may require Factory Acceptance Testing (FAT) prior to shipment.

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- Default passwords shall be changed before commissioning. Firmware shall be authenticated by the manufacturer. Management interfaces shall support secure authentication and encrypted communications where available.
- The Bidder shall provide a minimum of one day of operational and maintenance training.

5.1: Guarantees:

- **Bid Security (Tender Bond):** The Bidder shall submit a (Tender Bond) proposal security on a form like the attached format in Jordanian Dinars for a flat sum of (1500 J.D) (in a separate sealed envelope) (. The bond will be in the form of certified cheque or bank guarantee from a licensed bank, located in Jordan, selected by the bidder. The bidder shall ensure that the (tender bond) proposal security shall remain valid for a period of 30 days after the bid closing date or 30 days beyond any extension subsequently requested by the Purchase committee and agreed to by the bidder.
- **Performance Bond:** The winning bidder is required to submit a performance bond of (10%) of the total value of the supplies amount awarded to him within the duration mentioned in the award notification letter and before signing the Purchase Order (Contract) on a form similar to the attached format to guarantee that the winning bidder shall perform all works required in accordance with the Purchase Order's (contract's) technical specifications and requirements – **Annex\4 (the duration of this guarantee must fit with the implementation of the purchase order (contract))** . This guarantee shall be released after final handover and official acceptance of MODEE of all works done by the winning bidder and submission of the maintenance and support and warranty guarantees.
- **Maintenance and Support Bond:** The winning bidder is required to submit a maintenance and support bank guarantee to guarantee that the bidder shall perform all maintenance and support work needed. This guarantee shall be (5%) of the total value of supplies provided by him on a form like the attached format and for duration of (3) three years as of the date of final handing over and official acceptance by MODEE – **Annex\5**. This guarantee shall be released after its expiry and after the winning bidder provided all required support and maintenance and acceptance of MODEE.
- **Manufacturing Defects Liability Warranty:** The winning bidder should provide a manufacturing defects liability warranty on a form similar to the attached format duly endorsed and signed by a notary public for a duration of (3) year as of the date of final hand over- **Annex\6**. The manufacturing defects liability warranty

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shall be released after its expiry and after the winning bidder provided all required warranty works if required and acceptance of MODEE.

- The Bidder guarantees that all provided supplies are 100% brand new free of any manufacturing defects or in material and of a modern style and its production did not stop and that the year of manufacture should be the same as the year of proposal submittal.

5.2: Financial Terms:

Bidders should take into consideration the following general financial terms when submitting their proposals

- All prices should be quoted in Jordanian Dinars including all costs, expenses, profits, governmental fees and taxes, in addition to sales tax for the bidders registered in the general sales tax , and others. Prices should be specified for each item.
- The type of contract will be a fixed lump sum price contract including all costs, professional fees, over heads, profits, and expensesetc.
- The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its proposal and MODEE will in no case be responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the proposal process.
- The bidders shall furnish detailed information listing all commissions and gratuities, if any, paid or to be paid to agents relating to this proposal and to contract execution if the bidder is awarded the contract. The information to be provided shall list the name and address of any agent, the amount and currency paid and the purpose of the commission or gratuity. Any proposal not accompanied by an acceptable proposal security (tender bond) shall be rejected by the tendering committee as being non-responsive pursuant to RFP.

The proposal security of the successful bidder will be returned after signing the Purchase Order (Contract) and furnishing the required performance security.

The proposal security may, in the sole discretion of the tendering committee, be forfeited:

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- If the bidder withdraws its proposal during the period of proposal validity as set out in the RFP; or
 - In the case of successful bidder, if the bidder fails within the specified time limit to sign the Purchase Order (contract); or furnish the required performance security as set out above.
-
- The performance guarantee shall be released after final hand over and official acceptance of MODEE of all works done by the winning bidder and submission of the maintenance and support and warranty guarantees.
 - The maintenance and support guarantee shall be released after its expiry and after the winning bidder provided all required support and maintenance and acceptance of MODEE.
 - **The manufacturing defects liability warranty** shall be released after its expiry and after the winning bidder provided all required warranty works and acceptance of MODEE.
 - The MODEE is not bound to accept the lowest bid and will reserve the right to reject any bids without the obligation to give any explanation.
 - Bidders must take into consideration that payments will be as specified in the tender documents under annex (1) and shall be paid after the successful fulfillment and acceptance of the scope of work defined for the services by MODEE.
 - The MODEE takes no responsibility for the costs of preparing any bids and will not reimburse any Bidder for the cost of preparing its bid whether successful or otherwise.
 - General Sales Tax must be specified in the offer for the bidders registered in the general sales tax or it will be assumed as part of the total value of the bid submitted by the bidder.

5.3: Legal Terms:

Bidders should take into consideration the following general legal terms when preparing their proposals:

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- The bidders shall not submit alternative proposal. Alternative proposals will be returned unopened or unread.
- The proposal shall be signed by the bidder or a person or persons duly authorized to bind the bidder to the contract. The latter authorization shall be indicated by duly-legalized power of attorney and a certified copy of this authorization is to be attached to technical proposal. All of the pages of the proposal, except un-amended printed literature, shall be initialed by the person or persons signing the proposal.
- The Ministry requires that all parties to the contracting process observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution process. Ministry will reject a proposal for award if it determines that the Bidder has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the contract in question.

Corrupt Practice

Means the offering, giving, receiving or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action of a public official in the procurement process or in contract execution.

Fraudulent Practice

Means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence a procurement process or the execution of a contract to the detriment of government of Jordan and includes collusive practice among Bidders (prior to or after proposal submission) designed to establish proposal prices at artificial non-competitive levels and to deprive government of Jordan of the benefits of free and open competition.

- Bidder shall not contact MODEE, or its employees, members of the tendering or the technical committees on any matter relating to its proposal to the time the contract is awarded. Any effort by a bidder to influence MODEE, its

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employees, members of the tendering or the technical committees or the tendering committee in the tendering committee's proposal evaluation, proposal comparison, or contract award decision will result in rejection of the bidder's proposal and forfeiture of the proposal security.

- A business registration certificate should be provided with the proposal.
- The laws and regulations of The Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan shall apply to awarded contracts.
- Proposals shall remain valid for period of (90) days from the closing date for the receipt of proposals as established by the Tendering Committee.
- The Tendering Committee may solicit the bidders' consent to an extension of the proposal validity period. The request and responses thereto shall be made in writing or by fax. If a bidder agrees to prolong the period of validity, the proposal security shall also be suitably extended. A bidder may refuse the request without forfeiting its proposal security; however, in its discretion, the tendering committee may cease further review and consideration of such bidder's proposal. A bidder granting the request will not be required nor permitted to modify its proposal, except as provided in this RFP.
- MODEE reserves the right to accept, annul or cancel the bidding process and reject all proposals at any time without any liability to the bidders or any other party and/withdraw this tender without providing reasons for such action and with no legal or financial implications to the Government of Jordan.
-
- MODEE reserves the right to disregard any bid which is not submitted in writing by the closing date of the tender.
- MODEE reserves the right to enforce penalties on the winning bidder in case of any delay in delivery as defined in accordance with the terms set

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in the Government Procurement Regulation no. (8) For the year 2022, and the instructions issued pursuant to it and their amendments

- All prices should be listed in **the Bidder's financial proposal**.
- Bidders must fill out, stamp and duly sign form of bid attached to this RFP under (Annex 2) and enclose it in their proposals. Proposals that do not include this signed format are subject to rejection as being none responsive.
- The winning bidder will be expected to provide a single point of contact to which all issues can be escalated. MODEE will provide a similar point of contact.
- No proposal may be withdrawn in the interval between the proposal submission deadline and the expiration of the proposal validity period. Withdrawal of a proposal during this interval will result in forfeiture of the bidder's proposal security.

Bidder Conflict of Interest Declaration

The Bidder hereby represents, warrants, and undertakes that:

- It has no actual, potential, or perceived conflict of interest in relation to this procurement process.
- It has not participated, directly or indirectly, in the preparation of the studies, designs, technical specifications, terms of reference, evaluation criteria, or procurement documents for this procurement in a manner that may provide it with an unfair competitive advantage.
- It does not have any financial, business, employment, family, personal, or professional relationship that may improperly influence, or appear to influence, its participation in this procurement process.
- It has not obtained, sought to obtain, or used any confidential, privileged, or non-public information that could provide an unfair advantage in this procurement process.
- Neither it nor any of its affiliates, shareholders, directors, officers, employees, agents, consortium members, or subcontractors has any undisclosed conflict of interest that could compromise the fairness, transparency, integrity, or competitiveness of the procurement process.

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- It shall promptly disclose to the Procuring Entity any actual, potential, or perceived conflict of interest that arises during the procurement process or contract implementation.
- It shall provide any information, declarations, or supporting documents reasonably requested by the Procuring Entity for the purpose of assessing compliance with conflict-of-interest requirements.
- It acknowledges that failure to disclose a conflict of interest, or the submission of false, misleading, or incomplete information, may result in rejection of its bid, termination of any resulting contract, suspension, debarment, or any other action permitted under the Government Procurement By-Law No. (8) of 2022, its amendments, and instructions.

5.4: Support and Maintenance, Warranty and Performance:

• Support and Maintenance:

All devices, hardware, software and any other components installed by the bidder must be supported and maintained for a duration of (3) three years starting from the date of final handing over and acceptance.

• Bidders Should provide in their proposals the following:

A . Bidders shall furnish with their proposals a separate list of the needed spare parts which the manufacturing company recommends to use under normal conditions for a duration of (10) years. The list should show the part number as issued by the manufacturing company, the quantity, the unit price and the total price; these prices shall be binding to the bidder for the duration mentioned above. The first party has the full right to request these spare parts within this duration for the prices mentioned in the aforementioned list and the spare parts must be 100% new and original (brand new).

B . Bidders must provide maintenance workshops and the needed spare parts for the supplies for a duration of at least 10 years or for the acknowledged working lifetime unless a different provision is included in the tender invitation. Bidders should provide with their proposals conditions of spare parts prices adjustment (Escalation Clause)

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as is in the country of origin, after expiry of the duration mentioned under item (A) of this clause.

- **Warranty:**

All devices, hardware, software and any other components installed by the bidder must be warranted for a duration of (3) three years starting from the date of final handing over and acceptance.

- **Performance :**

The winning bidder is required to submit **a performance bond** of (10%) of the total value of the supplies amount awarded to him within the duration mentioned in the award notification letter and before signing the Purchase Order (Contract) on a form similar to the attached format to guarantee that the winning bidder shall perform all works required in accordance with the Purchase Order (contract) requirements.

- The Detailed description, technical Specifications, catalogues; Brand and the Model of the offered supplies [RFID readers & RFID tags] must be mentioned clearly with the origin datasheet.
- A compliance letter stating that the technical specifications of the supplies proposed by the bidder comply 100% as a minimum with the specifications shown in this RFP.

(b) : The Financial proposal:

- The financial proposal should include a cost summary. The cost summary must provide a fixed price for the required supplies in Jordan Dinars for the overall scope of work including all expenses, overheads, profits, fees and taxes including sales tax ...etc... The bidder should submit the "Form of Bid" Annex.3 Annexed

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to this RFP duly filled and signed by the bidder.

- The financial proposal should include supplies value attached to this RFP duly filled and signed by the bidder's authorized representative.
